Casper was the child of Charles Basler and Sophia Merkel. Both parents were born in Michigan in 1878. Casper's brother Edward was born in 1918 and died in 1982 in Sanilac, Michigan. Charles and Sophia were married in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 1899.

Casper's paternal grandparents were Casper Basler and Catherine Beuaer. Grandfather Casper was born in Switzerland in 1830. Grandmother Catherine was born in France in 1840. Casper and Catherine had seven children: Amelia, John, Fred, George, Catherine, Adam, and Charles. George was born in Sanilac, Michigan in 1868.

Casper's uncle George (brother of Casper's father Charles) married Matilda Haggerty and they had eight children: Katherine, Eva, Eunice, Mildred, Marie, Hellen, Raymond, and Virginia.

The 1880 United States Census shows Casper's grandparents, Casper and Catherine, living with six of their children on a farm in Sanilac County, Michigan.

The 1900 and 1910 U.S. Census show Casper's uncle George and aunt Matilda and their children living in Sanilac, Michigan. The 1920 Census shows them living in Sandusky.

The 1920 U.S. Census shows Casper's grandmother, Catherine, living with her daughter Ameila and son-in-law M. James Howell, in Lexington, Michigan.
