Mrs. J. Renton Dies in Detroit / Lifelong Resident of Belleville Passes Away in Detroit Sunday

Westfall, and J.E. Westfall of this city**. Mrs. Renton, who was 78 years old, was born in Belleville and lived all her life there except for the past six months which were spent in Detroit with her daughter, Mrs. Jennie Freer. One other daughter, Mrs. Addie Skerrett and four sons, William, Samuel, George and Roy Coleman survive her***. Her husband, James Renton, passed away three years ago.

Funeral services will be held at the home of her daughter, 29 Geneva Ave., Highland Park, Tuesday afternoon at 2:30. Interment will be in Detroit.
