JANE #3 IRVING (THOMAS #2, (SPECULATIVE)1) was born Abt. 03 September 1826 in Tinwald Village, Dumfries, Tinwald, Scotland, and died 09 May 1902 in Chatham, Ontario, Canada. She married JAMES # PATTERSON 30 May 1847 in Tinwald Village, Dumfries, Scotland1, son of JAMES PATERSON and JEAN RICHARDSON. He was born 31 May 1829 in Hightae, Lochmaben, Dumfrieshire, Scotland2, and died 23 August 1905 in Chatham, Ontario, Canada.

I have been doing some work on Jane Irving and her ancestors. On the 1851 census of Applegarth she shows as age 22 born in Tinwald. I looked on the Tinwald parish register from 1820 to 1835 but could not find her baptism. The !851 census also shows Mary Edgar age 47 born in Tinwald as Jane's mother. The parish register shows Thomas Edgar having a daughter born 16 August 1800 and baptized 17 August 1800. The location was Shaws in Tinwald parish. The register does not give the name of Mary's mother. There are no marriage records for Tinwald that far back and the birth records only go back to 1789 so it seems we are at the end of the trail in Tinwald parish. There are entries for a Thomas Edgar and Nancy Kerr having a son Irving born February 24 1802 at Amisfieldtown and a son James Gilbert born Jan 12 1798 also at Amisfieldtown. The fact that Mary was born at Shaws suggests this is a different family from the ones born at Amisfieldtown.

Noted in the Annandale Observer of 30th July 1897

"Golden wedding - Canadian papers report: Golden Wedding of Mr & Mrs Patterson of River Road, Dover, Ontario on the 25th June last. - Couple married 50 years ago at Tinwald, Dumfriesshire and subsequently resided at Barrasgate, Cummertrees. 17 Years ago they emigrated to Canada - they have 10 children and 41 grandchildren"

This ties in precisely with the report I sent:

Applegarth marriage proclamations. [marriages were proclaimed in the Church of each party] [813A/2 fr 133] dated 30th May 1847

James Paterson in Fourmerkland and Jane Irving in Tinwald. Paid 2/6. married elsewhere.

Marriage in the Bride's parish was the norm, it would have been Tinwald sometime in June 1847.

Annand ale Observer of 9th May 1902. "At Chatham, Ontario, Canada, on the 11th February -Jane Irving, wife of James Paterson, formerly of Barrasgate, Cummertrees, aged 75 years"

I checked the MIs for Lochmaben old cemetery and there is only one which might fit. No 157. "In memory of Edward Paterson who died at Lochmaben on 4th December 1832 aged 82 years. Also Jean Paterson his spouse who died at Hightae 29th January 1830 aged 65 years"

Jane, wife of Mr. Patterson, Indian Creek Road, Harwich, died yesterday, aged 74 years, 10 mos and 10 days. Death was caused from heart failure. Deceased has been ill for over a year. Besides a husband she leaves a family of three sons and two daughters to mourn her loss. The daughters are Mrs Bartlett and Mrs Baby. The funeral will take place Friday afternoon at two o'clock, to the Maple Leaf Cemetery

Attached is my extraction of items in The Chatham Daily Planet of February 1902 from the National Library of Canada microfilm.

I note that Mrs Hodgson and Mrs Green are not listed as daughters!

The hardware company must be the forerunner of the Patterson Hardware which postponed its auction for James's death. A.H. Patterson is shown as being born in Harwich. In the 1880 Historical Atlas of Kent County the only Pattersons listed in Harwich are:-

David of Northwood post office, owner of lot 19 of the River Thames survey

J.A of Chatham post office, owner of lot 16 of concession 3 of the River Thames survey and lot 18 of the River Thames survey.

L. of Rond Eau post office, owner of lot 18 of concession 4 of Lake Erie survey Wilson of Guilds post office, tenant of lot 18 of the Lake Erie survey.

The 1891 census and the report of the golden wedding said that James and Jane lived in Dover township. This report says Jane died in Harwich concession 3 and the 1901 census showed them there so they must have moved over to live with J.A between 1897 and 1901.

I am also sending part of the 1880 map of Harwich Township. The concessions are shown in roman numerals so the property of James A seems to be just below the words "Great" and "Western" on the railway. Alex Mcdonald is on lot 17.

I wonder if A.H. of the hardware company is a son of J.A.
